OFFICIAL DEMOCRATIC PARTY OF DENVER RECOMMENDATIONS:

AMENDMENT 60 Colorado Property Taxes NO
Cuts school funding, already pared back so far it hurts, by more than a billion dollars a year. Requires replacement from State General Fund. Cuts funds for police, fire, snow removal, water, parks & recreation, etc. Overturns hundreds of local votes to "De-Bruce" over the past 18 years.

AMENDMENT 61 State and Local Debt Limitations NO
Forbids debt by loan in any form and severely limits bonds. Shuts down ability to build or expand our roads, schools, water facilities, improvements; requires tax rates be reduced after a bond is paid back no matter what. Most municipalities, counties, and school districts will be bankrupted.

AMENDMENT 62 Definition of "Person" NO
Applies the term 'person' to every human being from the beginning of biological development, i.e. a single fertilized egg is a person with inalienable rights, due process, and requiring equal treatment under the law. Goal to make abortion illegal even in cases of rape, incest or mother's health, and to ban birth control such as the morning after pill.

AMENDMENT 63 Health Care Choice NO
Strictly partisan amendment that will lead to lawsuits and drive up costs for Colorado families already struggling with health care bills. There is no "opting out" even if passed, it is superceded by Federal law, and it has no place in our constitution.

PROPOSITION 101 Motor Vehicle, Income, and Telecom Taxes NO
Slashes state budget up to \$1.4 billion in the first year alone, leading to lost teacher jobs and increased class size. Reduces funding up to 1/10th of current for road and bridge construction, health and human service, criminal justice, and higher education. Dramatically reduces City & County revenues.

PROPOSITION 102 Criteria for Setting Bail and Type of Bond NO
Will result in more (most) innocent-until-proven-guilty defendants remaining in jail while awaiting trial or buying bail bonds from the bail bonds industry. Unfairly targets lower income defendants. Incurs additional incarceration expense so bail bondsman can profit.

INITIATED ORDINANCE 300
Extraterrestrial Affairs Commission NO POSITION
Would create greater government transparency about the issue of UFO sightings and extraterrestrial encounters
